## 2017 COMPOST & APPLIANCE DROP-OFF SITE

APRIL 15<sup>th</sup> thru NOVEMBER 18<sup>th</sup>

ACCEPTED ITEMS FOR THE COMPOST/APPLIANCE DROP-OFF SITE	RULES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grass clippings (curbside disposal is prohibited)</li> <li>Leaves</li> <li>Miscellaneous compost including flowers, garden plants, etc. (curbside disposal is prohibited)</li> <li>Small tree/bush stumps</li> <li>White Goods – Appliance Drop Site: AC units, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, freezers, microwaves, ovens/ranges/stoves, refrigerators, washers/dryers, water heaters</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Village residents only!</b> – Identification Will Be Required</li> <li>Place items on correct piles – Compost or White Goods</li> <li>Stack Appliances Neatly – do not throw in pile</li> <li>Compost – remove plastic bags/containers</li> <li>No garbage, recyclables, construction materials, iron, or tires</li> <li>No hazardous materials</li> </ol>

## 2017 BRANCH CHIPPING

The Wood Chipper will tour the Village to chip brush/branches **ONLY**  
**EVERY MONDAY – April 10<sup>th</sup> thru October 30<sup>th</sup>**  
(no chipping during holiday weeks)

- Branches must be curbside by 6:30 a.m. Monday mornings; 3” max. diameter - cut ends facing street.
- No Stumps/No Compost; 20 minute time limit per address applies.
- Per Village Ordinance 187-21, the property owner or occupant is responsible for disposal of entire tree and all branches as a result of tree removal. This will not be chipped by Village chipper.

**Due to the curbside branch chipping collection service, the Village DPW has a surplus of woodchips.**

- Residents can pick up woodchips at the DPW yard waste site at 649 S. Main St. during compost open hours on Saturdays. Bring your own containers and pitch fork/shovel – tools and containers are not provided.
- The DPW will deliver only full truck loads (3-5 yards) of chips to residential addresses upon request. We do not come back to pick up any unused woodchips. Call the DPW at 284-0545 to arrange delivery.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Furniture – <u>1 large piece only</u></li> <li>Carpeting</li> <li>Toys</li> <li>Small amts. of construction material (1 cubic yard max)</li> <li><u>ONE</u> box spring/mattress set only</li> <li>Other miscellaneous items intended for landfill</li> </ol> <p><b>Loads will be inspected for acceptable items.</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Village residents only!</b> (identification will be required)</li> <li>Batteries should be placed along concrete wall.</li> <li>No waste oil, anti freeze, paints, liquids, or hazardous waste</li> <li>No recyclables, dirt, sod, brush, grass clippings, leaves, compost, concrete, rocks, bricks, concrete block, iron, or tires allowed.</li> <li><b>No Electronics – including but not limited to:</b> TVs, Computers, monitors, printers and peripherals, Fax machines, Photocopiers, VCRs &amp; DVRs, Telephones with video displays.</li> </ol>
