Miscellaneous compost including flowers, garden plants, etc. (curbside disposal is prohibited)</li> <li>4. Small tree/bush stumps</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Village residents only!</b> – (identification will be required)</li> <li>2. Place items on correct piles. (including plastic bags)</li> <li>3. No garbage, white goods, recyclables, construction materials, iron, or tires</li> <li>4. <b>NO BRUSH DROP-OFF AT COMPOST SITE!</b></li> </ol>

ACCEPTED ITEMS FOR THE DUMPSTER	RULES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Furniture – <u>1 large piece only</u></li> <li>2. Carpeting</li> <li>3. Toys</li> <li>4. Small amts. of construction material (1 cubic yard max)</li> <li>5. <u>One</u> box spring/mattress set only</li> <li>6. Other miscellaneous items intended for landfill</li> </ol> <p><b>Loads will be inspected for acceptable items.</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Village residents only!</b> (identification will be required)</li> <li>2. Batteries should be placed along concrete wall.</li> <li>3. No waste oil, anti freeze, paints, liquids, or hazardous waste</li> <li>4. No appliances, recyclables, dirt, sod, brush, grass clippings, leaves, compost, concrete, rocks, bricks, concrete block, iron, or tires allowed.</li> <li>5. <b>No Electronics – including but not limited to:</b> TVs, Computers, monitors, printers and peripherals, Fax machines, Photocopiers, VCRs &amp; DVRs, Telephones with video displays.</li> </ol>

## 2011 BRANCH CHIPPING

The Wood Chipper will tour the Village to chip brush/branches **ONLY**

**EVERY MONDAY - April 4<sup>th</sup> thru October 31<sup>st</sup>**

(no chipping on holiday weeks)

Branches must be curbside by 6:30 a.m. Monday mornings; 3" max. diameter - cut ends facing street

No Stumps/No Compost; 20 minute time limit per address applies

Due to the curbside branch chipping collection service, the Village has a surplus of woodchips. Residents can pick up woodchips at the residential yard waste site at 649 S. Main St. You need to bring a container and a pitch fork or shovel. The Village will deliver woodchips, however, a resident must accept a full truck load (3-5 yards) and the Village will not come back to pick up any unused woodchips.
