

Public Works Minutes

March 15, 2022

Public Works Chairperson Trevor Seitz called the meeting to Order at 5:32 p.m.

Village Administrator Dawn Wagner gave the Statement of Public Notice

Members: Trevor Seitz-present, Andy Hebein-present, Peter Janus-present, and Dan Helm-present

Helm reported on the 2021/2022 Snow Removal

- 320 ton of Salt was used to this season. (below average)
- 90 ton alone was used on the last ice storm.
- The only major breakdown for the season was a cracked trip edge on a wing. Staff welded it to get us through the season but a permanent fix is scheduled in spring. All other breakdowns were fixed by DPW staff.

Helm provided an update on the 2021 Projects/Equipment

- The new salter was installed last week on our F-550 (\$614) under budget.
- The pre-wet spray tank was delivered yesterday (DPW staff is installing to keep it under budget about \$300).
- Munson will be installing the fence at Grady Park in the next week or 2. Due to the rise of steel pricing the DPW staff removed the old fence and post to save about \$3,000 to keep it within budget.
- JK contractors will be starting the roof at Schowalter park next week. The DPW salt shed roof and pole barn gutters will be done after.
- The gutters at the firehouse had to be special ordered and will be here and installed in April.
- The firehouse parking lot will be sealed and stripped this spring by NR asphalt.
- Struck & Irwin is scheduled to slurry seal Fransee Lane this summer.
- The Ozaukee County highway department was hired to do shoulder work on Technology and Klein Ln. They will also be painting the Center line and fog line on Progress and paint the fog line on Dekora Woods.
- Holton Brothers is scheduled to start the work on the bandstand the last week of April. DPW staff will be painting it when the concrete work is finished.
- Cameras will be getting installed at the DPW facility next Wednesday.

OTHER MATTERS

- The railroad company is working with the state to get permits to repair the railroad crossing on STH 33.
- The Street cleaner is going through the Village this week.

- A forestry head was rented from Brugginks rentals to finish up tree work. (Showalter, Sumac, Cottontail)
- DPW staff will be getting the parks ready in the next week or 2 for the season with bathrooms being delivered April 1st.
- Curbside brush chipping begins April 4th.
- The Compost Site opens April 9th. (spring dumpsters will be the weekends of April 16th and 23rd)
